


## **FEST WRAPS UP ITS ANNUAL CONGRESS**



**Brussels, 15 October 2025** – The European Federation of the Sanitary and Heating Wholesale Trade (**FEST**) successfully concluded its annual Congress, "Empowered to Impact: Sustainable Transformation of the Sanitary and HVAC Sector", held in Warsaw from 25–27 September 2025. The event brought together over 125 industry leaders from across Europe to chart the sector's path toward a more circular and competitive future.

Over a full day of keynotes, debates, and case studies, participants agreed that sustainability is no longer only a necessity or distant ambition—but also a major opportunity. Positioned at the heart of Europe's value chains, the wholesale sector can accelerate the green transition by enabling transparent product data, efficient logistics, and new circular business models.
